I hope that everyone had a great Fourth of July Celebration with family and friends.



We are pleased to announce the itinerary for the 2013 Italy Vacation. Cost is \$2,050 per person which includes airfare, hotels, bus transportation, breakfast and dinner. A \$300 deposit per person is needed by June 28 to secure this amazing price. Final payment is due July 30.

Itinerary is as follows:

September 28	Depart Logan Airport, Boston, September 28 .
September 29	Arrive in Rome. Stay overnight in hotel. Dinner included (sightsee)
September 30	You can be on your own to roam the city or we can make reservations to see the sights. Guided sightseeing tour is optional and additional fee.
October 1	Move along to Montecasino. Breakfast and dinner included.
October 2	Visiting Assisi and Siena.
October 3	Visiting Florence and Pisa.
October 4	Arrive in Lettomanoppello. We will be staying in Letto until we go home but we will be taking 2 day trips, one to L'Aquila, second trip TBD.
October 5-8	Feste Patronali. Feast every night in Lettomanoppello.
October 9	Day of rest and visiting the town of Letto.
October 10	Depart VERY early in the morning (2 am) to come back to the USA.

While we are in Lettomanoppello, the people there would like to host you. If you have relatives there or the same last name they would like to know. There are two bed and breakfast inns if you would like to stay there, I will check into cost for you.

All monies need to be paid by check to the travel agency for the airline ticket and then payable to Carmela Reali for the bus and hotel. Also included in price is a tip for the bus company and for shirts for all travelers.

ALL MONEY DUE BY JULY 30, 2013. I will look into travel insurance as all sales are final.

If you do not have your passport, please apply as soon as possible. You should check your medical insurance for international travel as hospitals in Italy may not accept your medical insurance. This is IMPORTANT.



