### Band Beginnings – 25 years ago

In the summer of 1988 Dick Capozza was asked by Richard Kelley if he would put together a band to play a concert in memory of Joe Romano, the founder of Romano's Band in Portland, Maine.

For many years Romano's Band performed during the three day "Feast of St. Rocco" at St. Peter's Italian Church on Federal St. in Portland, and Mr. Kelley thought it would be appropriate to have a memorial concert in his honor at this same event. Mr. Capozza agreed, and in August, 1988 this "pickup band" performed a memorial concert for Mr. Romano in front of St Peter's Church. The band's bass drum player, Frank Sangillo, was also a member of the Italian Heritage Center in Portland, and asked Mr. Capozza if he would consider keeping the group together with the IHC as its sponsor. Mr. Capozza thought that would be a good idea, reorganized the Band, and on December 23rd 1988 the Italian Heritage Center Community Concert Band performed its first concert.





