In last month's newsletter there was an error stating key cards would remain active until July 31, 2014. The correct wording from the By-Law book is as stated...

**Section 3. DUES PAYMENT.** Dues shall be payable in advance annually for a period of twelve (12) months by July 1<sup>st</sup>. If dues are not paid by July 1<sup>st</sup>, that member will be carried as delinquent to October 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year, at which time the delinquent member will be automatically dropped from the membership rolls. In order to return as a member, that person must go through the reinstatement process. During the time of delinquency, a member cannot hold a valid key card and is considered a non-member. When delinquent, members must pay a full years dues to continue uninterrupted membership.


