BACK BY POPULAR DEMAND: **REVISITING CHRISTMAS EVE**

Since we had such positive feedback last year concerning our “Seven Fish Dinner” or as the Italians call it “**La vigilia di natale**” we will continue to make this an annual event as long as it remains a function that everyone is interested in attending.

This is the celebration of Christmas Eve and considered the most festive night of the year. While holiday meals are an integral part of our social culture, Christmas Eve is a special time for families to attend mass and then gather with family and friends to celebrate and reminisce about the past.

This year the Cultural Committee has decided to try different recipes from different regions of Italy. The Committee has chosen the following menu:

**Appetizer:** Calamari salad, baccala salad, and roasted peppers (roasted in the oven).

**Soup:** Lentil soup with carrots, celery, onions and potatoes topped with roasted chestnuts.

**Pasta:** Family style pasta with olive oil, tuna fish, leeks, chick peas, sun dried tomatoes, capers, garlic, anchovies and wine.

**Entrée:** Baked haddock, scallop scampi, shrimp scampi; broccoli di rapa and fried cauliflower.

**Dessert:** Homemade cannoli and Struffoli which is made of tiny dough balls that have been deep-fried and soaked in honey. They are served piled high on a plate and are frequently covered with multi-colored sprinkles or confetti. Coffee.

**Wine:** Two bottles of wine per table.
