NEW SCHOLARSHIPS for 2016

At the March 17, 2016 Board Meeting, the IHC Board of Directors approved implementation of two new IHC administered scholarships. They are the Germani Family Scholarship and the IHC Employee Scholarship. Both scholarships will be awarded this summer with the recipients receiving the awards in time for the 2016 -2017 academic year. These new scholarships will be in addition to the four IHC Scholarships approved by the Board in January of this year. For 2016, the IHC will award five \$1,500 scholarships to members or their dependents and for the first time a \$1,500 scholarship to an employee of the IHC. The Scholarship Committee extends their appreciation to all individuals who helped make these scholarships a reality.

GERMANI FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

On March 3, 2016, Louis Germani, a past President of the IHC, passed away. His family stated that one of his proudest achievements was the starting, along with his wife and others in 1953, of the social club now known as the Italian Heritage Center. Lou was intimately involved in every aspect of "the Club." He served for many years as an officer of the IHC, including serving as its President and Parliamentarian. He was instrumental in the construction of the current IHC facility. During his retirement years, Lou spent most mornings at the IHC, solving the world's problems with his buddies in "the Muffin Club."

In order to memorialize Mr. Germani, his late wife, Rose, and their intimate attachment to the IHC, their family has established the Germani Family Scholarship to be administered by the IHC Scholarship Committee with funds deposited in the IHC Charitable Trust. Louis and Rose's children are very pleased that the IHC will be able to offer the first annual Germani Family Scholarship this year. They anticipate that this will become a yearly event.

The IHC Scholarship Committee is very pleased to be able to add another scholarship in memory of past members this year.

IHC EMPLOYEE SCHOLARSHIP

For the first time this year, the IHC will be offering a scholarship to an employee of the Center. When the Scholarship Committee envisioned the scholarship, they decided to offer \$500 this year. At the March 17 Board Meeting, the Board of Directors concurred and agreed to offer the scholarship this year. Carl Paquette, Chairperson of the Scholarship Committee, announced the new scholarship at the general meeting. When questioned as to the amount, Carl stated that the committee had raised the money and didn't want to exceed funds. Dominic Reali stood and said "double the amount" and later changed his comment, to add a total of \$1,000 to the approved \$500. Due to the generosity of Dominic and Linda Reali, the first IHC Employee Scholarship will be for \$1,500. Although the new scholarship will be similar to other IHC administered scholarships, it will focus on how employment by the IHC has benefited the employee and how they perceive the scholarship will assist them. Employees will also have to acquire a recommendation from a member of the IHC. Scholarship applications are currently available in the IHC manager's office.

Meet Annie Haeger, Olympic Sailing Hopeful

Annie is the daughter of IHC members **Kent and Julie DiBiase Haeger** who is the daughter of the late **Domenic DiBiase** and member **Anna (DiMillo) DiBiase**. Although Kent and Julie reside in Fort Lauderdale, Florida they maintain their membership at the IHC.



Annie's introduction to sailing began at the ripe age of five, and by the age of eight she was entering and winning single dinghy sailing events, both nationally and internationally. While a student at Boston College she was All-American in sailing all four years and as a senior was named Eagle of the Year. This award is the highest honor of BC's Athletic Department, given annually to one male and one female senior student-athlete who are outstanding citizens, leaders, scholars and athletes.

But after graduation Annie set her sights on a loftier goal - Olympic Gold in Women's Division 470 racing. To which end, Annie and her teammate Briana Provancha have been training rigorously for over three years

In late February, Annie and Briana placed 6th overall in the women's division at the 2016 470 World Championship, an achievement that gives the duo the inside track for the U.S. Olympic Team headed to Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, this summer.

Along the way, in New York City, on March 3rd '16 our Olympic hopeful, was presented the US Sailing Rolex Yachtswoman of the Year awards for 2015. The IHC can be proud to say it has a horse in the race at the 2016 Summer Olympics in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. Needless to say, the Portland area DiBiase and DiMillo families will be cheering Annie on with the hopes of becoming intimate with Olympic Gold.
