

101 Reasons to be Proud Your Italian

Reason # 8 HAND GESTURES

Communicating in Italian involves more than uttering words & forming sentences. The words & sentences have nuances that must often be given shape in space. An Italian whose hands are tied is, in some ways, rendered speechless.


Walking down the streets of Italy, particularly in the south, you will see animated Italians hopping up & down, gesticulating wildly. A cupped hand shaking at the wrist. Two palms pressed together, pivoting in unison. A hand flicked under the chin. They're not just talking: they're giving life to the words that go beyond speech.

che cosa? - what Madonna! Basta! - that's enough Tu si pazzo! - you are crazy

Even if you don't speak a word of Italian, if you see the accompanying gesture, you get a sense of what is being conveyed.

Ask an Italian for directions & suddenly he or she is one with you, the terrain, & your ultimate destination.. They may be saying "Sinistra a la Chiesa (left at the church), sulla collina (up the hill), e sempre dritto! (and straight ahead), but the words really don't matter much: their hands become churches, streets, stoplights, rivers, monuments.

The Italians have turned communication of this kind into an art form. A dance of the spirit. It is the joyous physical manifestation of emotion & conviction that can't be trapped in the uttered phrase. There is a physicality to the Italian culture that makes these gestures a natural extension of the language. When two Italians meet, a mere handshake will not suffice. Male or female, young or old, the two parties must embrace & give the other a friendly kiss on each cheek. It is this exchange that forms the basis of the communication that follows: friendly, intimate, & animated.
