101 Reasons to be Proud Your Italian

Reason # 9 - HOLLYWOOD HOT SHOTS

From the earliest days of the motion picture industry, Italians have played a vital role in all aspects of filmmaking. One of the first films to deal with Italians was called, appropriately enough *The Italian* (1915). This silent film told the story of a young man's immigration to America and the injustices he faced there.

A few years later, one of the first sex symbols of Hollywood appeared, an Italian by the name of Rudolph Valentino. *The Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse* (1921) launched a career that had audiences swooning. Many films followed, but he is perhaps best remembered for his role as Ahmed in *The Sheik* (1921). With his face partially hidden behind a veil, Valentino's large, round eyes won the hearts of many a filmgoer. When he died in New York in 1926, eighty thousand mourners showed up, causing a near riot. Mayhem also ensued at a second funeral on the West Coast.

More than seventy years later, people are still falling in love with Italians. Leonardo DiCaprio is the latest in a long list of Italian heartthrobs to grace the silver screen.

But it's not just their good looks that have brought them success in the movie business, for many great Italians have toiled behind the scenes as well. For decades Frank Capra enjoyed the status of one of Hollywood's most popular directors. Aside from directing such classics as *It Happened One Night* (1934) and *Mr. Smith Goes to Washington* (1939), Capra will always be remembered for *It's a Wonderful Life* (1946). Starring James Stewart, this feel good Christmas story has found a worldwide audience that continues to grow year after year.

By contrast, one of Hollywood's hottest directors today is Quentin Tarantino, who because of his gritty crime dramas *Reservoir Dogs* (1992), *Pulp Fiction* (1994), and *Jackie Brown* (1997), could be considered the anti-Capra. His directorial style is tough and unrelenting, much like that of his heroes Martin Scorsese and Francis Ford Coppola.

Many great films offer a glimpse into the daily lives of Italian Americans in a frank, human, and sometimes humorous manner, exposing the rich Italian heritage to a mainstream audience. *Moonstruck* (1987), starring Nicolas Cage (a real Italian, in spite of his surname) and Cher is a lighthearted look at opposites attracting. Cher plays Loretta Castorini, a widow who falls in love with Ronny Cammareri (played by Cage), the brother of the man she is supposed to marry. Set against the backdrop of a moonlit New York City, this is a wonderful, touching comedy. More recently, actor-writer-director Stanley Tucci's *Big Night* (1996) portrayed two Italian brothers struggling to make it in the restaurant business as they prepare the meal of their lives for the great Louis Prima, rumored to be coming to their restaurant for dinner. Few films have displayed the attitude of Italians toward food better than this one, and it's hard to watch it on an empty stomach!

Italian American actors are always on Hollywood's A-List: Robert DeNiro and Al Pacino, stars of *The Godfather Trilogy* and other landmark films of the twentieth century have set the standard for serious actors of their generation. Marisa Tomei, star of *My Cousin Vinny* (1992), won the Academy Award for Best Supporting Actress for her comic role. Four years later Mira Sorvino, daughter of acclaimed actor Paul Sorvino, won the same award for her comic breakthrough performance in Wood Allen's *Mighty Aphrodite* (1995). Anne Bancroft and Susan Sarandon, also of Italian American descent, have been honored with Academy Awards as well.

In front of and behind the camera, inside and outside the studio, in mega blockbusters and in small, independent films, Italians have made their mark on American film history. Intense, emotional, volatile, and romantic, they have brightened the hours we spend in darkness staring at the silver screen.
