(3rd notice)

Recording Secretary: The Recording Secretary shall be present at and keep records of all regular and special meetings of the Center and the Board of Directors.

The Recording Secretary shall prepare and mail all notices of said meetings and perform such other duties as may be assigned by the President. The Recording Secretary shall attend to all correspondence pertaining to the Center and, upon termination from office shall deliver all records or property belonging to the Center to his or her successor. The Recording Secretary shall receive a stipend to be established annually by the Board of Directors in its sole discretion.

Article X Vacancies Section 1: In the event of a vacancy declared by the President resulting from the death, resignation or removal of a Primary Officer, Elected Director, the position shall be filled by a special election to be called by the President or, in the absence of the President, by the Vice President. This election shall be held at the next regular meeting following the notice of vacancy. All members shall be notified of the vacancy in writing at least seven (7) days before said meeting. A plurality vote shall be sufficient to fill the vacancy. Any Primary Officer, Elected Director, or Activities Director who has been removed or has deems to have resigned pursuant to these By-Laws is not eligible to be nominated or elected in the special election.

Did you know that a traditional Italian American Christmas Eve celebration typically consists of seven different seafood dishes?

Hence: The Feast of the Seven Fish!!

This celebration commemorates the wait, ***THE VIGILIA di NAT ALE***, for the midnight birth of the baby JESUS.

Italian American families have been known to celebrate with nine, eleven or even thirteen different seafood dishes. The most famous dish Southern Italians are known for is baccala (salted cod fish). The custom of celebrating with a simple fish such as baccala is attributed to the habitually impoverished regions of Southern Italy.

A typical Christmas Eve meal may include anchovies, whiting, lobster, sardines, smelts, eel, squid, octopus, shrimp, mussels and clams. The menu may also include pastas, vegetables, baked goods and homemade wine.

The menu for our observance this year consists of:

ANTIPASTI: Seafood Salad comprised of baccala, calamari, shrimp, and either mussels or clams complemented with oven roasted red peppers.

PASTA: Frutti di Mare comprised of linguini in a garlic shrimp and scallop red sauce with a hot pepper oil served on the side for those who like a more spicy flavor.

SECONDI: A haddock dish TBD and broccoli rape

DOLCI: An assortment of Italian pastries

Bread served at each table.

Two bottles of wine served at each table. Red & White



**REASON # 12
ITALIAN-JEWS**

Italy has a long and proud Jewish Heritage. Jews were among the first inhabitants along the Tiber River. Since the earliest days of the Roman Empire Jews lived in and around Rome, and today the city continues to be the heart of Italian Judaism. There are approximately thirty thousand Jews in Italy, centered mostly around Rome and Milan.

In the earliest days of Venice, many Jews lived on the lagoon as traders and bankers and were part of the seafaring economy. In 1516, Jews were forced to move to a small island, which became known as the Ghetto Nuovo, from which the word “ghetto” derived. Cramped together in tiny quarters with limited social and economic activities, the Jews in the ghetto bonded together. All of the major cities had their ghettos, where, for a time, Jews were forced to live but were allowed to practice their religion without interference.

When Napoleon’s regime swept through the region, igniting the fires of Italian liberty, Jews were freed from the ghettos and allowed to live where they please. After Napoleon’s fall, many voices still cried out for Jewish liberty. In Turin, King Carlo Alberto officially emancipated them on March 19, 1848. Subsequently, many became involved in the cause of Italian unification. Isaac Artom, secretary to one of the Italian founding fathers Camillo Cavour, was Jewish, as was Giacomo Dina, the publisher of Cavour’s newspaper *Il Risorgimento*.

Because Jews have been active in every segment of Italian society, their culture has been completely assimilated. If you think Italian food is good, try Italian-Jewish food, with its own special take on meatballs and caponata.

During Mussolini’s Fascist regime, Jews were persecuted once again, and many of them were carted off to Germany to become victims of the Holocaust. But many heroic Italians came to the aid of Jewish neighbors, hiding them from the Nazis. After the war, the Italian-Jews raided their synagogues from the rubble and rebuilt their communities in harmony with the rest of the battered nation. Author Primo Levi has chronicled the Jewish-Italian experience of the era in several novels. Vittorio De Sica directed the *Garden of the Finzi-Continis* (1970), a drama about Italian-Jews during the war, which won an Oscar for Best Foreign Film of that year.

While most people associate Italians with Catholicism because of the presence of the Pope in Vatican City and because the vast majority of Italians are Catholic, the Italian-Jewish legacy is unique and enduring.


