
## CHARITY



# 101 REASONS TO BE PROUD YOU'RE ITALIAN



## REASON # 17 OPERA



Opera is the music of Italy's soul. It originated in Florence during the Renaissance when a group of musicians and philosophers, called the Florentine *camerata* (meaning "friend" or "society"), revived Greek drama, adding a musical line to the development of the plot. They called this musical rendition of the dramatic story the recitativo. In the early seventeenth century, the first great Italian opera composer, Claudio Montenerdi, added the idea of melodic songs, called arias, that the characters in the play, rather than the chorus, would actually sing. These two elements, combined with elaborate scenery and costumes, formed the basis of opera as we know it day.

Italian operas were of two types - opera seria, or serious opera usually based on classical myths; and opera buffa, or comic opera, which began as comic relief to be played and sung during the intermissions of an opera seria. In 1778 the crown jewel of Italian opera theaters, La Scala, opened in Milan with a production of Antonio Salieri's *Europa Riconosciuta*. Despite having been bombed in World War II, La Scala remains the premier opera venue in the world today, and no diva or great tenor can be said to have truly arrived on the opera scene until he or she has sung there.

Italian opera flourished and blossomed in the nineteenth century, stimulated by work of the great composers Vincenzo Bellini, Gaetano Donizetti, Giacomo Puccini, Gioacchino Rossini, and of course, the great Giuseppe Verdi. Together, these musical geniuses established the classical repertoire of Italian opera, giving us works like *Norma* and *La Sonnambula* (Bellini); *La Bohème*, *Madama Butterfly*, and *Tosca* (Puccini); *Lucia di Lammermoor* and *Don Pasquale* (Donnizetti); *Il Barbiere de Seviglia*, *Guillaume Tell* (Rossini) and *Aida*, *La Traviata*, *Rigoletto*, and *Otello* (Verdi). These works continue to be performed throughout the world, and their melodies are familiar to music lovers everywhere. Rossini's famous "William Tell Overture" has become popular in America because it was the theme of the radio and television drama *The Lone Ranger* of the forties and fifties.

In the United States, the art of the opera was revitalized again by an Italian named Gian-Carlo Menotti. He was born in Cadegliano, Italy, and began writing librettos at the age of ten. He came to America in 1927, and his career flourished. His most famous works, *The Medium*, *The Consul*, and *Ahmal and the Night Vistors*, established an American opera tradition for modern times.

Opera is about passion, drama, and emotion. Its themes of betrayal, love, death, and intrigue are universal but heightened by the larger-than-life spectacle that a full-blown opera performance presents. The story line, the costumes, the settings, the full orchestral accompaniment to the great tenors, sopranos, and the other singers on the stage, all combine to give us the first truly multimedia art form. And it's not surprising of course, that something so dramatic, emotional, and intense was born in Italy.


