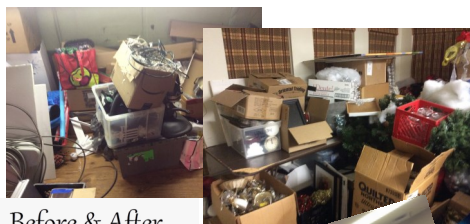
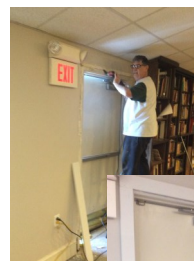

Thank you **Tom Watson** for showing of you carpentry skills with new trim on the exit door in the Library!

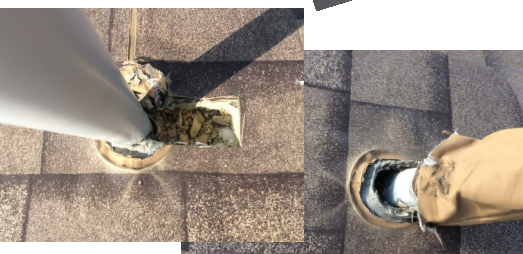
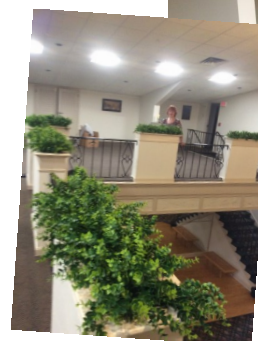
I want to thank **Nikki Cox** for coming down to paint the new trim around the exit door and also painting the base-board along the floor in the Library

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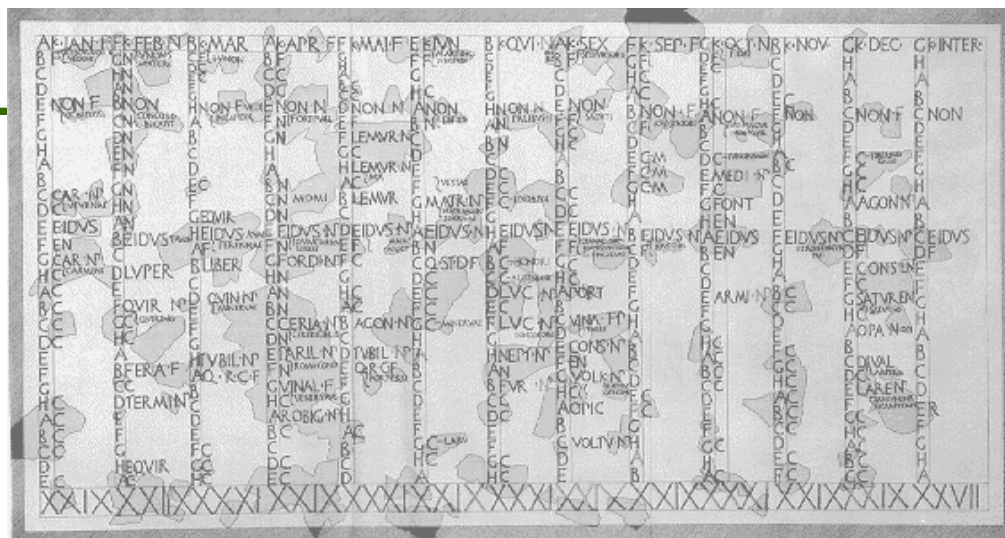
II CALENDARIO ROMANO *THE ROMAN CALENDAR*

Sometimes Italians themselves are surprised by the influence the inhabitants of their narrow, boot-shaped peninsula have had on the ways of the world. Consider the calendar by which we measure the days of the week, the months of the year, and the years of the centuries. Calendars make it possible for us to keep a record of the past and make plans for the future. Without them we are stranded in an eternal present, where there is no history and there can be no dreams.

The ancient Egyptians made the remarkable discovery that a year was divided seasonally and could be measured from the shortest day of the year to the next occurrence of the shortest day. They devised a calendar of 365 days divided into three seasons of four months each: winter, spring, and summer. From Persia, the Egyptians got the idea of naming the months. Had the Egyptian calendar prevailed, we would be talking about Thorth, Tybi, and Pachons instead of January, February, and March.

But of course the Egyptian calendar did not prevail. At about the same time the Egyptian calendar was established, across the Mediterranean a legendary prerepublic ruler by the name Numa Pompilius was devising an almanac. He named the months according to some of the Roman deities (Janus, Mars, and Juno, for example) and others according to their numerical occurrence during the year (September, October, November, December - in Numa's calendar the year began in March, so these were the sevenths, eighth, ninth and tenth months). Later, the months of July and August (Quintilis and Sextilis in Numa's calendar) were named after Julius and Augustus Caesar.

In the early days of the Roman Empire, the calendar was observed haphazardly and perpetuated many irregularities. In the first century B.C., the Roman astronomer Sosigenes advised the emperor Julius Caesar that important modifications had to be made to standardize the calendar and regularize the position of the seasons. Because of the nonobservance of leap years and other astronomical realities in the centuries intervening between Numa and Caesar, January was now occurring in autumn! The Julian calendar, later slightly modified by Pope Gregory in the sixteen century, became the prototype of the calendar you carry around with you in your day planner. So the next time you jot down an appointment for July 5th or August 27th, for example, think of Julius and Augustus Caesar and how Rome's great legacy still organizes our lives today.



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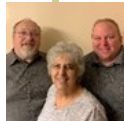
