2 BOARD OPENINGS

We have two **(2) openings on the Board: Membership Secretary**, We will have nominations and voting on Thursday, December 16th. **PLEASE BRING YOUR KEY CARD**

MEMBERSHIP SECRETARY: The Membership Secretary shall collect and account for all, dues and special assessments of the membership as established by the Board of Directors.

The Membership Secretary shall maintain a roster of current members and keep accurate records of the membership with respect to payment of dues, issue notices of dues payable, and perform such other duties as may be required by the Board of Directors.

The Membership Secretary will also serve as Secretary of the Membership Committee. Upon termination from office, the Membership Secretary shall deliver all records and other property belonging to the Center to his or her successor.

The Membership Secretary shall be bonded, the cost of which shall be borne by the Center. The Membership Secretary shall receive a stipend to be established annually by the Board of Directors in its sole discretion.

TREASURER: The Treasurer is the chief financial officer of the Center. The Treasurer is responsible for the proper safeguarding of and accounting for all funds of and monies received by the Center. The Treasurer has the authority to sign checks. The Treasurer is also responsible for supervising the Bookkeeper. The Treasurer must possess appropriate educational and professional credentials. The Treasurer shall be bonded, the cost of which shall be borne by the Center.

SECTION 3: No regular member shall be allowed to place his name in nomination for any Primary Office or the position of Elected Director unless that member has been in good standing for at least one (1) year immediately prior to nomination night and intends to carry out the duties and responsibilities required by the office or position.

ARTICLE X VACANCIES SECTION 1: In the event of a vacancy declared by the President resulting from the death, resignation or removal of a Primary Officer, Elected Director, the position shall be filled by a special election to be called by the President or, in the absence of the President, by the Vice President.

This election shall be held at the next regular meeting following the notice of vacancy. All members shall be notified of the vacancy in writing at least seven (7) days before said meeting. A plurality vote shall be sufficient to fill the vacancy. Any Primary Officer, Elected Director, or Activities Director who has been removed or has deems to have resigned pursuant to these By-Laws is not eligible to be nominated or elected in the special election.

Borsa di Studio Scholarship



It was to Lucania, a desolate land in southern Italy, that Carlo Levi—a doctor, painter, philosopher, and man of letters—was confined as a political prisoner because of his opposition to Italy's Fascist government at the start of the Ethiopian war in 1935. While there, Levi reflected on the harsh landscape and its inhabitants, peasants who lived the same lives their ancestors had, constantly fearing black magic and the near presence of death. In so doing, Levi offered a starkly beautiful and moving account of a place and a people living outside the boundaries of progress and time.
